

Diocese of San Angelo Coronavirus Protocols to remain in effect until further notice

Recognizing the announcement that the governor of Texas has opened all businesses 100%, our bishop has made the decision to continue to keep our current COVID-19 policies and procedures in place. Ensuring the safety of all those who come to Our Lady of Guadalupe remains the highest priority for the Diocese of San Angelo. For these reasons, there will be no immediate changes in our approach to prevention. Masks and social distancing will still be required when on the grounds of the parish. While we are very excited about getting back to a pre-COVID normal, that will all come at a later time. I am confident that the bishop will consult with health officials and leaders within the government about the next steps to take.

By the grace of God and endless prayers from so many of Mother's warriors, His light broke through and my son miraculously came out of it! That was 7 years ago and since then my son has become a teacher and enjoying his life in Christ Jesus and living his Holy Catholic faith!! We never give up on our beloved because He never gives upon us!
