

Ave María Devotions



Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Recuerdo que desde que tenía uso de razón, más o menos unos 5 años, mi madre y yo rezábamos el Santo Rosario todos los días, algunas veces en la casa y otras en la Iglesia. De esta manera mi madre iba sembrando en mi corazón la semilla del amor a nuestra Madre Santísima. Mi mamá era una mujer santa, tenía muchas virtudes y una capacidad extraordinaria de amar y perdonar, sus problemas, se les solucionaban con gran rapidez, yo pienso que eran milagros. Porque todo lo dejaba en las manos del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y la Virgen Santísima y con alegría y de buen humor seguía adelante, y es que esa es la hermosura de una Fe bien vivida. Con el ejemplo de devoción de mi madre, lo que aprendí de la vida de la Virgen y viendo la dulzura y dolor en su rostro con su corazón atravesado por un puñal de la Virgen Dolorosa, donde rezábamos el rosario, despertó en mí, amor y agradecimiento. Empecé a querer ser de Su agrado, como corresponderle a Su amor y sacrificio.

Recordaba Sus palabras en la de boda de Cana, "haz lo que Él te diga", y como yo creía que la única manera de ser obediente, buena y piadosa, era siendo monja. Así siempre estaría cerca de Jesús y María, los necesitaba mucho, con la pérdida de mi

padre fallecido y otros problemas que me afectaban mucho y yo no sabía resolver. Me dediqué a orar y rezar el Rosario con devoción, y sería monja porque la paz solo la hallaba en Jesús y María.

A los 16 años llegue a este país, me envolví en otras actividades, las enseñanzas de mi madre quedaron en el olvido. Ya la devoción al rosario dejó de ser mi prioridad. Con el tiempo me case con Guadalupe Cedillo, y yo que no sabía nada de la Virgen de Guadalupe, me intereso mucho saber de sus apariciones, mensajes, milagros. Fui sintiendo que yo le pertenecía, que nada era casualidad, ahora yo era Guadalupeana, aunque no perteneciera a esa asociación. Desde entonces y con la soledad de no tener a mi madre conmigo, puse toda mi atención y devoción en mi madre Santísima. En 1980 nació mi tercer hijo, una niña preciosa pero muy enfermita, la bautizamos, le pusimos el nombre de María como la Virgen y después con todo el dolor de mi alma, se la entregue, pidiéndole que fuese Ella su madre. Fueron unos años muy difíciles, el llanto, dolor, coraje se apoderaban de mí, pero la Virgen de Guadalupe, paciente, amorosa, esperando y sufriendo, como lo hacía con Jesús, que me abrazaba y calmaba mi dolor con Sus bellas palabras. "Porque tienes miedo, no estoy yo aquí que soy Tu madre". Claro que si, además Ella era la única que podía comprender el dolor de una madre que sufre. Ya veníamos a misa, la Eucaristía y mis rosarios al ser constantes me iban sanando. Me arrepiento que solo a veces rezábamos el rosario en familia, pero no con la frecuencia que debíamos, sin embargo ha sido de gran ayuda espiritual para mis hijos que mi esposo y yo lo recemos. Ella es el camino para llegar a Jesús, y creo firmemente que si la amo a Ella, ya estoy amando a Jesús. La devoción a la Virgen y al rosario ha existido en mi familia por muchas generaciones. Y vemos como las bendiciones y los milagros suceden en nuestras vidas. La Virgen María intercede por nosotros y nos ha prometido que los que recemos el rosario con fe recibirán Su protección y las Gracias más grandes. Esta es solo una de Sus promesas. Gracias Virgen Santa, nunca te apartes de nuestro lado, te amo. Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, en Vos confié. Sagrado Corazón Inmaculado de María, en Vos confié. ¡Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe!

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Since I can remember, when I was about 5 years old, my mother and I prayed the Holy Rosary every day, sometimes at home and sometimes at Church. In this way my mother was sowing in my heart the seed of love for our Blessed Mother. My mother was a holy woman, she had many virtues and an extraordinary capacity to love and forgive, her problems were solved very quickly, and I think they were miracles. Because she left everything in the hands of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Blessed Virgin and with joy and good spirits she continued on, and that is the beauty of a Faith well lived. With the example of my mother's devotion, what I learned from the life of the Blessed Mother and seeing the sweetness and pain in her face with her heart pierced by a dagger of the Sorrowful Virgin, where we prayed the rosary, awoke in me, love and gratitude. I began to want to be liked by her, how to reciprocate her love and her sacrifice. She remembered her words at the wedding at Cana, "do what He tells you," and since I believed that the only way to be obedient, good and pious, and to be a nun. That way I would always be close to Jesus and Mary, I needed them a lot, with the loss of my deceased father and other problems that affected me a lot and I didn't know how to solve them. I dedicated myself to prayer and to pray the Rosary with devotion, and I would be a nun because peace was only found in Jesus and Mary.

When I was 16 years old, I arrived in this country, I got involved in other activities, and my mother's teachings were forgotten. Devotion to the rosary is no longer my priority. Eventually I married Guadalupe Cedillo, and I, who knew nothing about the Virgin of Guadalupe, was very interested to know about her appearances, messages, and her miracles. I began to feel that I belonged to her, that nothing was a coincidence, now I was Guadalupeana, although I did not belong to that association. Since then and with the loneliness of not having my mother with me, I put all my attention and devotion on my Blessed mother. In 1980 my third child was born, a beautiful but very sick girl, we baptized her, we named her Mary like the Virgin and later, with all the pain in my soul, I gave her to her, asking her to be her mother. There were very difficult years, crying, pain, anger took hold of me, but the Virgin of Guadalupe, patient, loving, waiting and suffering, as she did with Jesus, who hugged me and calmed my pain with her beautiful words. "Why are you afraid, I am not here, who am your Mother." Of course, she was the only one who could understand the pain of a suffering mother. We were already coming to Mass, the Eucharist and my rosaries being constant, were healing me. I regret that we only sometimes prayed the rosary as a family, but not as often as we should have, however it has been a great spiritual help for my children that my husband and I pray it. She is the way to reach Jesus, and I firmly believe that if I love Her, I am already loving Jesus. Devotion to the Blessed Mother and the rosary has existed in my family for many generations. And we see how blessings and miracles happen in our lives. The Virgin Mary intercedes for us and she has promised us that those of us who pray the rosary with faith will receive her protection and the greatest Graces from her. This is just one of her promises. Thank you Blessed Mother, never leave our side, I love you. Sacred Heart of Jesus, in you I trust. Sacred Immaculate Heart of Mary in you I trust. Long live Our Lady of Guadalupe!
