## Religious Education Mission

**Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, by the grace of the Holy Spirit, will strive to bring parents, guardians and children of the parish into a deep, personal communion with Christ and His Church, and to foster in them a missionary zeal for souls by:**

- **Proclaiming the Word of God and His loving plan of salvation as expressed in Holy Scripture and the Sacred Tradition of the Catholic Church;**
- **Acknowledging every person as a child of God, uniquely created by the Father in His image and likeness;**
- **Teaching the Person of Jesus Christ, the source and summit of all life, through whom we are granted our salvation.**

## The Parent/Guardian and Catechists Partnership

**“Parents are the principal and first educators of their children” (CCC 1653). The home is where a child should first experience the Catholic faith. The parish Religious Education aims to work in partnership with parents/guardians, in order to assist them in living their vocation of their children. The Religious Education program should complement, not replace, the catechesis that children should receive in the home.**

**We are asking parents to get involve with your children and partner up with your child’s teacher. You can be a Guardian Angel (GA) for your child’s class. A Guardian Angel helps the teacher with activities, such as; making calls to parents/guardians for festivities, helping with Catechists Appreciation Week, etc...**

**GA will meet to plan for the class activities. A separate calendar will be given to GA on first meeting.**

**GA will resume as soon as we get back into the classrooms.**

## Role of a Parent/Guardian

The Religious Education program assists parents in their God-given role as educators of the Faith by:

- Providing the truth of the Roman Catholic Faith as handed down by Jesus Christ through Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition, the Magisterium, and the Church Fathers
- Providing weekly religious education classes for children, parents or guardians from recorded lessons.
- Providing the opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration.
- Providing opportunities to receive the sacrament of Confession

It is of utmost importance that children are given the opportunity for weekly Sunday attendance at Holy Mass and frequent participation in the Sacrament of Confession. It is difficult for children to grasp what they are being taught about the Word of God if they do not experience the Sacramental life first hand.

## Role of Students

Students should be punctual and prepared for class. They should be ready as if they were in a classroom setting.

- Parents have a sacred place for your child to do the lessons.
- Students are turn in homework before the next lessons are sent.
- PK & K grades parents can help the students with the activities and lessons during class. (Will resume at a later time)
- 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grades First Communion class parents are required to help students with the lessons and activities.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> graders can do their activities and lessons on their own, but any parent can be there to help and support them.

Every student has the right and privilege to learn in an environment where others are well behaved, and this includes “home”. Similarly, every teacher has the right to teach in such an environment.

## Retreats

**1<sup>st</sup> year Confirmation Retreat will be one day. (TBA)**

**2<sup>nd</sup> year Confirmation is three days. Confirmation students need to have 2 retreats before making their Confirmation Sacrament.**

## Called To Protect Program

**In August 2016, the Diocese of San Angelo adopted the new Safe Environment curriculum *Called to Protect*. This year of 2021/22, will be our sixth year to use this program. It is a program that teaches skills to parents/guardians and students how to help keep safe from people that want to harm children and teens. Child molesters are skilled at “grooming” children, making friends with them, finding ways to have children and young adults trust them.**

**Parents/Guardians and students will be trained through catechists who have been trained in this program.**

**Parents/Guardians will have a one day training, either in Spanish or English on two separate days. (Please look on dates below). Students will have three days of training during their class time. It is very important that parents/guardians and students attend these training sessions. (Please refer to announcements for CTP trainings in your bulletins)**

## Family Adoration

**Student & Family Adoration will occur once a month throughout the religious education class year. We will try to bring students and their families to do Adoration on the day of their classes. As long as we are experiencing distancing. We are also encouraging virtual Adoration on the days scheduled.** Students are given the opportunity for worship and express faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. Proper manners in God's house should be stressed and reviewed for a short time during the class session prior to the Adoration. Parents are encouraged to attend. (Please look at your calendar for dates.)

## Progress Reports

Catechists will provide a standard written evaluation of a student's progress twice during the religious education class year (December and April). Progress Reports will include the student's understanding of the material covered as reflected by test scores, student's completion of homework assignments, prayers mastered, class participation, and a student is maturing in his/her Catholic life, but they do reflect how well they comprehend the material being presented.

## Attendance / Absentee Policy

**Attendance will be recorded each week after receiving class homework. Students will receive a recorded lesson to a parent's phone number. If a parent does not have any device to receive lessons, they will need to pick up lessons to have a written schedule**

of lessons and activities to do at home. Parents are encouraged TO turn-in their work to their teacher by email or message before the next lesson.

If student does not turn in homework, they will be considered absent. They will be required to make-up that absence. They will write a summary of the MASS gospel and chapter lesson they missed if not turned in on time. If an activity was accompanied with the lesson, they will turn that activity in as well.

Regular attendance is very important. The total scheduled class time for 2021-2022 year is 43.5 hours per student, so please make every effort to minimize absences and get your child to turn in homework. Students cannot miss more than 4 days of class time. Excessive absences could result in a child's not being prepared to receive the sacraments.

With every absence, students will have homework to make up for each day absent. (Copy of Make-up for Absences form included in handbook)

## Class Cancellations

(This applies ONLY if we return back to OLG classrooms)  
If we cancel any Home-based classes, your child's catechist will notify you.

If Midland County Public Schools cancel school for the day and dismiss school early due to inclement weather, or if MISD's afternoon and evening activities are cancelled, then it's a possibility that Religious Education classes for that day are likewise cancelled. (Please note that if Monday REC are cancelled due to an emergency declared by Midland County, this does not mean that the next day's, Tuesday's classes, are cancelled as well.) If REC cancels classes, for whatever reason, we will attempt to send you a text message. You can

also get on our FB page under “Our Lady of Guadalupe Religious Education” for cancellations. When in doubt contact OLG office at 432-682-2581. Please also check our website: [www.olgmidland.org](http://www.olgmidland.org) (Please also read your bulletin for cancellations or changes.)

## Dress Code

We ask that particular care for modest dress be observed at all times, but most especially on the days when Adoration are scheduled.

**Students are expected to wear modest clothing to class, even if it's virtual.** Short shorts, tops which do not cover the midriff area, pants hanging off of hips, mini-skirts, spaghetti straps, and other similarly immodest articles of clothing are prohibited. Graphic depictions or written references to drugs, alcohol, or weapons, as well as graphic or connotative profanity or sexual references may not appear on any clothing. If any disciplinary action is needed, it will be administered with Christian love and understanding.

## Classroom Discipline

In the event that a student's classroom behavior is disruptive, the catechist will:

- Not allow the disruptive situation to persist in the class
- Not embarrass the child in front of classmates
- Speak to the child and try to encourage the student to change their behavior.
- If the student continues to be disruptive, they will be asked to log off the classroom.
- The Director of Religious Education will speak to the student's parent and asked to work with their child and the catechist to have this behavior corrected.

# Drop-Off and Dismissal Policy

**(This will be in affect when classes resume at OLG classrooms)**

The following safety regulations have been formulated to ensure the safety of each student and will be strictly enforced.

- **Drop Off:** At the discretion of the parents, students in grades 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup> may be dropped off in front of the RE building and allowed to walk in unaccompanied, they will sign themselves in.
- **Pick Up:** At this time, parents are asked to walk up to the CCD building look for the grade of their child (posted outside) and the catechist will bring them to you.

Parent/Guardian that will need someone else to pick up their student will need to call/text the catechist and give the name of the person picking them up.

- For the safety of all the students, no child will be dismissed early from class, unless the parent/guardian comes in to pick up their child.

Please pick up your child **NO LATER** than 15 minutes after class. If students are still waiting for parents/guardians after 15 minutes, we will make 2 calls; one to parent/guardian and second to your emergency contact. If there is no contact on either phone numbers and it's after 8pm, we will need to contact the Midland Police Department. Please make sure contact numbers are updated.

# Sacramental Preparation

A central aspect of the Religious Education program is preparing children to receive the sacraments. Children are prepared for the reception of the sacraments of Penance, Eucharist, and Confirmation. This preparation involves both parents/guardians and students **(in the classroom setting)**. Please take note of and attend the various parent/guardian meetings. Please encourage your children involved in sacramental preparation to submit required assignments when due.

This year we are really stressing that Sponsors for sacraments also attend Parent/guardian classes as well **(classroom setting only)**.

There are meetings on the calendar for parents/guardians of students receiving First Penance, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. Attendance at these meeting is expected.

**Please refer to the bulletin for rehearsals for First Holy Communion and Confirmation practices.**

## SACRAMENTAL RETREATS:

There are First Reconciliation and First Eucharist Retreats that the students and their parents/guardians are required to attend. At this time we are planning our retreats and will update you as we approach the sacraments.

Two Confirmation Retreats are also required before a student receives their Confirmation sacrament. At this time we are planning our retreats and will update you as we approach the sacraments.

## SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be Catholic
- Be 18 years of age
- Must have sacraments of:
  - \*Baptism   \*First Communion   \*Confirmation
- If married, must be married in the Catholic Church.
- Must be a practicing Catholic. Please bring copy of all sacramental certificates to office as soon as possible. If you are having two sponsors, certificates from both parties is a must. Church Marriage Certificate for married couples.



## Emergency Procedures

If a student becomes ill and cannot turn in homework when it is due, please let the catechist know so they can set a time for make-up work.

**For virtual Classes:**

**If the student becomes sick or injured during class, the parent can log the student out. Please let your child's catechist know.**
